The following minor corrections have been identified since publication.

Page	Description
199	<i>The subscription television service, favoured by 64 per cent</i>) was described... Correction: The bracket (highlighted in yellow) should be a comma.
322	<i>180. Michael Usher, email to Michael Thurlow, 9/4/1989.</i> Correction: The year (highlighted in yellow) should be “2019”, not “1989”.
405	<i>Under this model, a generic state, national, and international bulleting is produced...</i> Correction: The word “bulleting” (highlighted in yellow) should be “bulletin”.
